Partnering with Aviation

In September Chip was able to partner with a new outreach associated with the aviation ministry. Our pilot, Lloyd Peace, grew up on the Amazon. From his childhood he has a number of national missionary and pastor friends that he helps with their outreaches in various areas along the upper Amazon. Ney, a national pastor, works along with Brazilian missionary Sebastião. They have a new outreach in a community called Castelo. Lloyd and Chip left on a Friday morning and returned Sunday morning. The trip was about 2 hours by plane and both legs were smooth flying, that is except for the part where Lloyd let Chip take the controls ☺.

Castelo, a village of about 80 people, lies along a pristine lake that was full of jumping fish when we arrived. They jumped all throughout the day, apparently

running from piranhas and Chip noted no one entered the water. The dogs barked all night which was apparently unusual. He was informed a jaguar was in the neighborhood.

The workday began with a short service where Pastor Ney and Chip presented the Gospel. As Lloyd helped with construction of the church building, Chip did consults all the first day and half the second. He saw 56 people and operated on one. When the consults were done he also helped on the construction, again amazed at how much can be done with so little. Only tin for a roof and nails were brought in. All wood was cut to size with a chainsaw. The basic structure was framed out and a roof placed during their stay.

Please pray that the Lord will bless Ney's and Sebastião's work in Castelo.

Hospital Celebrates 30th Anniversary

The Amazon Baptist Hospital has been functioning for 30 years as of Sept. 2015. We planned a large community outreach for October that attracted over 2000 people. In addition to circus-type games for children, we had booths with health-related topics. Laurie's booth was called "Ameba in the Kitchen" and addressed how people inadvertently contaminate their food (boil coffee and run it through a dirty reusable filter or cook noodles only to rinse them with "dirty" sink water). There were also screening tests like blood sugar, blood pressure, blood typing and eye exams available. The highlight of the event was a 20 minute blackout/shadow presentation that presented the Gospel chronologically from Genesis to Revelation. Please pray that presentations at the fair will help people learn to be healthier, and that those who heard the Gospel will make a decision to follow Christ.
